Stay Healthy & Safe Policies

Dear Summer and Day Camp Families,

We hope you are as excited about summer as we are at Camp Cavell. Although these past few years have been challenging, we know that sunshine combined with laughter is good for the soul and we have lots of fun in the sun scheduled in our Cavell summer camps and programs. We know that you have questions about what summer camp will look like this year.

Our summer day camp model has been modified to put the health and safety of our campers and staff first as we strive to capture the magic of summer amidst all of these additional steps. With guidance from the American Camping Association and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), we are following COVID-19 safety precautions within our programs that include practices such as lower staff to camper ratio, social distancing, frequent handwashing and enhanced sanitation practices.

We have been and will continue to monitor developments regarding the COVID-19 outbreak and will follow any state or local directives pertaining to child care and youth activities. As summer is quickly approaching, we wanted to update you on our COVID-19 camp safety protocols.

- **Group Size:** Group sizes will be limited and we will respect guidance regarding camp group ratios.
- **Daily Screening:** All campers will be temperature-checked, and we will ask parents a set of questions about their child(ren) and their family's recent health. We will send any child home that demonstrates a fever or sickness and will offer a free COVID test if presenting with symptoms.
- **Drop-off:** Please allow for additional time at drop-off for screening. Parents will be asked not to enter facilities or cabins. PLEASE NOTE: Children presenting with a fever (100.4 or higher) will not be allowed to return to camp for 14 days without a doctor's note indicating sickness is not related to COVID-19 and that the child is medically approved to return to the camp or program.
- **Masks / Face Coverings:** Staff and campers can wear masks or face coverings if they would like. All campers and staff will be required to wear face masks on buses. We ask that campers bring their own face mask each day.
- **Hygiene:** Scheduled handwashing breaks will be built into each group's schedule. In addition, there will be hand sanitizer stations throughout the building.
